

Jobseekers Allowance (JSA) Claimant Numbers by Age

The NOMIS labour market database allows the extraction of JSA numbers by broad age bands, which is useful for measuring young people affected by unemployment. The JSA figure is a narrower definition of unemployment than the Government's preferred ILO measure of unemployment, in that it only records those who have signed on as unemployed, but who are actively seeking work. The actual number of young people who are unemployed is likely to be higher than the JSA figure.

To complement the existing Hampshire County Council's Ward JSA report for working age claimants, this report provides claimant numbers by gender for young age groups and the remaining 25+ group:

Aged 16-18: This captures a smaller group, as JSA is only paid out to 16 or 17 year olds in exceptional circumstances. Most young people in this age group will be aged 18.

Aged 19-24: This age group represents the number of young people on unemployed benefit claimants post Academic Year 14

Aged 25 plus: This age group captures the remaining JSA claimants up to age 64, and provides a comparisons between young people and 'older' people.

Aged 18-24: This is a standard age band used to measure the core number of young people on JSA.

Aged 16-24: This is the age band often used for young people unemployment, using the Government's preferred ILO measure of unemployment. It is not possible to provide ILO unemployment at the ward level. As there are few 16 and 17 year olds claiming JSA the 16-24 rate is always lower than the 18-24 rate.

Rounding

For reasons of disclosure the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) round claimant numbers to the nearest five. A zero in a cell can mean either no claimants or up to two claimants. The total is rounded from the raw figure to the nearest five and will not necessarily equal the sum of the rounded male and female numbers.

The district figures are extracted separately and rounded by DWP. This means the sum of the wards in a district will not necessarily equal the district total. Aggregating from the individual ward numbers will introduce rounding error. The 16-18, 19-24 and 25 plus rates are calculated from the 2010 MYE tab. The 18-24 and 16-24 District numbers and rates are taken directly from the ONS District Age and Proportion dataset.

Rates

The NOMIS labour market database provides ward rates by total and gender, as per the Ward Report, but not by age below district level. As current NOMIS rates are calculated from 2010 Mid year estimates (MYE), the age rates in this report are calculated from a bespoke ONS 2010 MYE lookup (see - 2010 MYE tab), except for age 18-24 and 16-24 that are taken directly from ONS data. Age 16-18, 19-24 and 25 plus rates are derived from the rounded JSA totals and should be taken as indicative rates. The volatility of claimant numbers from one month to the next can cause significant rate changes at the ward level. In most cases the ward gender rate is too small to make a meaningful rate.

Interpreting the data

It is important to look at three numbers when interpreting the data at the ward level.

The claimant number: rounded to the nearest five at source, so a zero does not necessarily translate as no unemployed young people in the ward.

The mid year estimate total population: this number estimates the total population in that age group. A large or small population will influence the rate - see 2010 MYE tab.

The rate: used for comparative purposes is based on the rounded claimant number and should be viewed as indicative. Wards with smaller young people populations (2010 MYE) can see relatively high rates from a small number of claimants. This is often the case in rural wards. Conversely, urban areas with significant young people populations with high claimant counts can have low rates.
