



# Services for Young Children

Opportunity for an early years childcare provider

Aldershot, Hampshire GU11 3SL - Phase 1

The lease of a Hampshire County Council building based on the site of Park Primary School, Aldershot has become available for an experienced early years childcare provider. We are looking for a childcare provider to operate a setting from the premises that is of high quality, self sustaining and offers affordable childcare services to meet the needs of the local community. The successful childcare provider will have a proven track record of delivering the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) at an Ofsted good or outstanding level and be able to demonstrate their experience of achieving high quality inspection outcomes and their commitment to high quality staff development to ensure good outcomes for children.

The provision is required to offer a full range of inclusive childcare services for children aged 2-4 years and will provide Early Years Education (EYE) universal (15 hours) for 2, 3 and 4 year olds and extended (30 hours) funded places for working parents who meet the government's 30 hours childcare offer.

The provision could offer a full range of childcare services for children aged 0-8 years, depending on the Ofsted registration. The availability of the premises could be all year round allowing childcare to operate through the school holidays. The provider will work in partnership with the school and Hampshire County Council's Family Support Service that currently operates from and shares part of the building.

Support is available to the new provider from Hampshire County Council's Services for Young Children team.
