Supporting families, Transforming lives

Transform is a consortium led by Barnardo's and consisting of 3 main partners; Motiv8, Family Lives and Step-by-Step and forms the county wide provision under the Hampshire Supporting Families Programme. Our simple mantra is that we are here to help families with support and guidance which is not 'more of the same' but a step change in the way that services are provided.

We are committed to working in partnership, not just together, but with the widest range of practitioners and providers from across Hampshire including voluntary, statutory and other organisations; acting as the glue that brings these organisations together to help families in a seamless, co-ordinated and outcome focused way. This process will be led by Transform and put simply our approach is: **1 Family, 1 Plan, 1 worker.**

## What the Service will offer...

Our staff are dedicated, tenacious and committed to each family, working with them to help them understand their needs and identify outcomes that they want and need to achieve. We talk with the families, not to them, ensuring that we look at them as individuals and as a family unit and not just focusing on the problems.

Our practitioners will undertake a range of support, challenging the families to progress with work ranging from getting children and young people out of bed and into school in the morning, building attainment and attendance, to evidence based interventions with the family in areas such as communication, parenting skills, crime reduction, home management and more. Our practitioners will work hands on with the family, identifying the causal factors and Helping to put in place real, practical and simple solutions. We will work in partnership to provide specialist support in areas such as Domestic Violence, Substance Misuse, and Mental Health. In addition our trained staff will assist in training, education and skills development to get adults back into work with real life changing opportunities.

As a Service we are accountable to both the families and our partners, we want to know when things are not working, and make sure we change and develop to meet the outcomes and high standards that we set ourselves.

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What we need from you...

We need the High Level Family Plan, agreed and signed by the family. Unfortunately we cannot start work with the family until this has been signed. We also need a warm hand over, in other words that families know who we are and what we will be doing, and a joint first visit with the lead professional. We are not about telling families what they have to change, but helping them identify their needs and challenging them throughout our work to change.

## Sue's experience:

### Sue Sainsbury; Barnardo's Strategic Children's Service Manager Hampshire

Sue has worked for Barnardo's for the past 10 years. During this time she has managed and developed child sexual exploitation services, Missing Service and Family Support services across Hampshire, Portsmouth and Southampton, and the wider South East region.

As well as significant contribution to research and best practice development, Sue also sits on the research board for the DFE Safe Accommodation project for sexually exploited and trafficked young people.

Over the past 28 years, Sue has gained much experience in working directly with vulnerable young people, their families and young people who have suffered abuse. Sue qualified as a social worker in 1989 and was involved in many joint investigations as a trained joint interviewer. As a qualified Social Worker Sue has case held numerous complex families and individuals and has specialist knowledge in areas such as Domestic Abuse, Substance Misuse, Mental Health, Sexual Abuse and Exploitation, as well as working with adult Survivors of childhood sexual abuse.
