## **Buriton, following the Shipwrights Way**

**Distance:** 3 miles

**Start:** Public parking area on B2070

The parish of Buriton lies immediately south of Petersfield in eastern Hampshire. The South Downs form a magnificent backdrop and this dramatic scenery, in the heart of the National Park, is also of international biological and landscape importance.

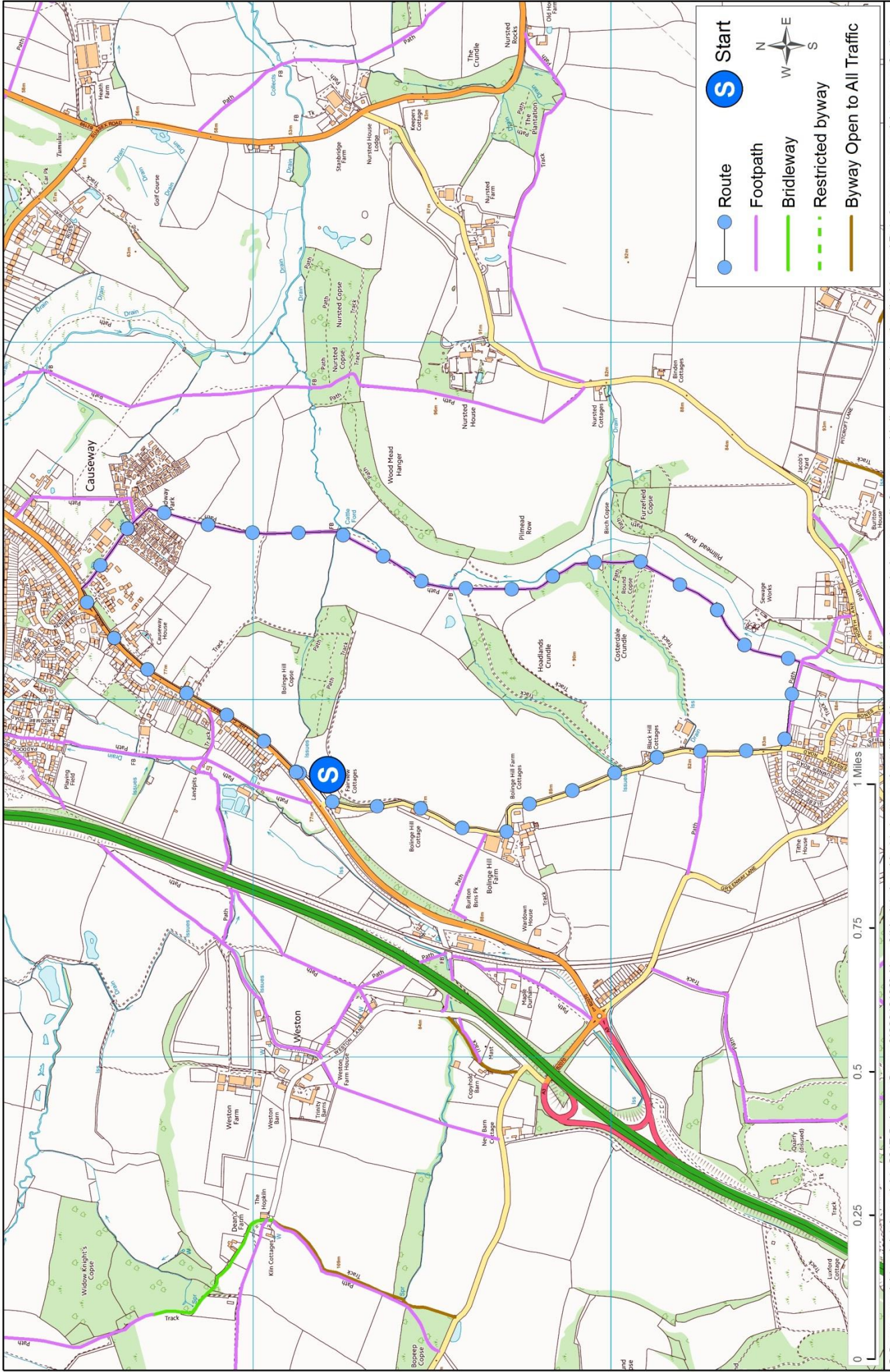
### **Directions**

A circular route (anti-clockwise) using parts of the Shipwrights Way and the Hangers Way – including some sections on local lanes.

Starts/ends at the public parking area on B2070 and follows the Shipwrights Way along Bolinge Hill Lane and Petersfield Road to Buriton village.

Returns northwards via the Hangers Way before turning left onto B2070 for the short distance back to the parking area. Take care on all stretches of local lanes.
