NPPS and Police 2015 Scheme - death grant expression of wish

Death in Service

You can use this form to express a wish for people or organisations to receive a death grant lump sum if you die in service. The grant is normally three times your annual pensionable pay at the time of death, or immediately before absence without pay. Refer to the NPPS or PPS 2015 Members' Guide for more information about survivor benefits.

Expressing your wish

If you wish for more than one person or organisation to benefit, please indicate the percentage of the grant you would like each to receive. If you don't do this, we will divide the grant equally between your nominees.

The form asks about each nominee's relationship to you. Only state this if you wish to, it will help us deal sensitively with matters if you die.

Changing your expression of wish

You can change your expression of wish at any time by completing a new form. You can cancel it by writing to Pensions Services. Your expression of wish will remain valid unless the nominee has died or you have cancelled it in writing.

You must update your nomination if your circumstances or wishes change otherwise any payment may not be paid as you would have wanted. Please also update your expression of wish if any nominees change their address.

About the death grant

An expression of wish does not override the provision that the grant will go to a surviving spouse, civil partner or declared partner, if you have one, but it would take effect if you have no spouse, civil partner or declared partner or if you and your spouse, civil partner or declared partner were to die at the same time.
