Hampshire Futures - Education Participation Team.

Providing young people with high quality Careers Information, Advice and Guidance (CIAG) and 1:1 supporting into employment, education and training. Tracking and monitoring destinations for young people across Hampshire and supporting where appropriate.

To do this we...

Work with young people aged 16 – 19 and support them to explore their ambitions, individually and sometimes in groups;

Work with young people and partners working with young people to identify and overcome potential barriers;

Work with young people applying for work, college, apprenticeships, traineeships etc. to help them present the best applications they can;

Explore opportunities that meet the young persons needs and help them find the right opportunities;

Continue to support them after they have engaged to ensure they maintain their positive outcome.

We also:

Undertake the September Guarantee and Activity Survey - Tracking all young people from the end of their year 11 until the end of their year 13 to identify if they are participating in Education, Employment and Training and if the Education, Employment and Training meets the Raising of the Participation Age. The majority of this happens over a 6 month period September to February.

From the tracking exercise we are able to identify who is NEET and then refer them to one of our Education, participation and Training Advisers or Progression Coaches.
