

Use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) or Drones at Calshot Activities Centre



Statement May 2017:

Calshot Activities Centre is located on private land and managed by Hampshire County Council (HCC). Hampshire County Council asks that unmanned aircraft (drones) are not operated from its land holdings. This follows guidance recently issued by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) to help drone pilots fly safely and responsibly by following the [drone code](#). In particular the Code requires that drones should be operated at least 150ft away from people and property.

The Drone Code

When you fly a drone in the UK it is **your responsibility to be aware of the rules** that are in place to keep everyone safe.

Don't fly near airports or airfields

Remember to stay below 400ft (120m)

Observe your drone at all times – stay 150ft away from people and property

Never fly near aircraft

Enjoy responsibly

Be Drone Safe:

- Always keep your drone in sight
- Stay below 400ft (120m)

Be Drone Aware:

- Follow the manufacturers guidelines
- Keep the correct distance away

Be Drone Legal:

- You are responsible for each flight
- Stay away from aircraft
