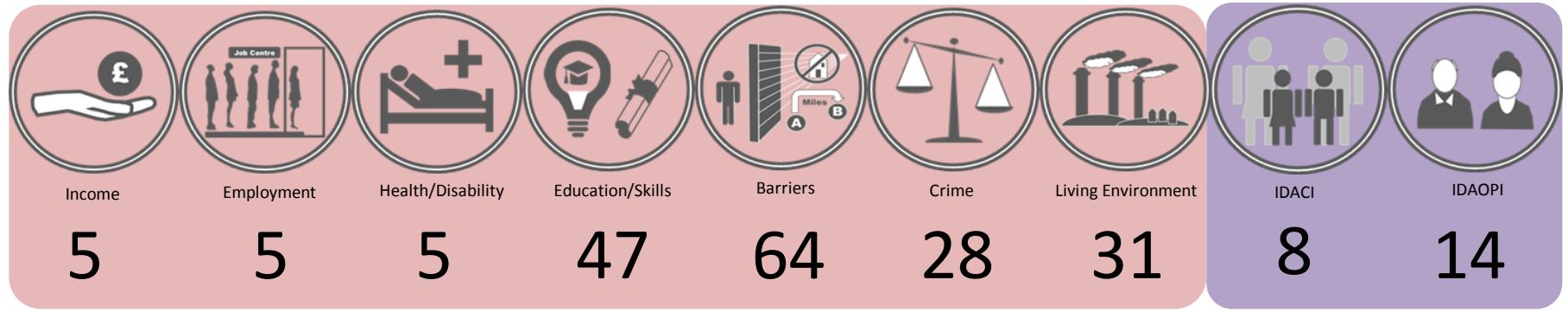

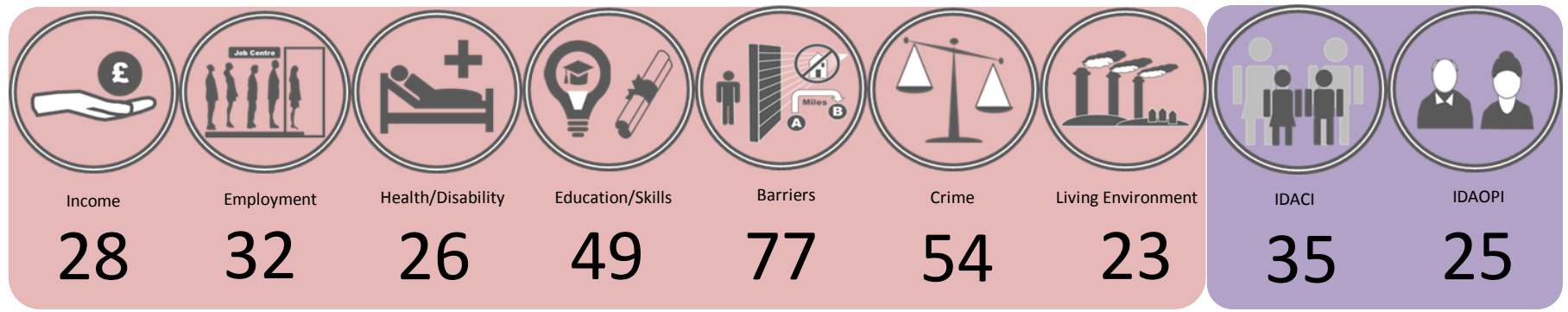

Seven types of deprivation that when combined and weighted produces the Index of Multiple Deprivation. Two supplementary indices: Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI) and Income Deprivation Affecting Older People Index (IDAOP). These two indices are sub-models of the Income domain, and as such do not feed into the Index of Multiple Deprivation.
