## There is still time for EU citizens living in Hampshire to apply to EU Settlement Scheme

Dear Provider

Nearly 42,000 applications have so far been made from Hampshire to the Government's EU Settlement Scheme according to the latest figures - an additional 5,360 people since December last year.

The scheme is **open until 30 June 2021** for anyone wishing to apply. **Are you aware of any staff or service users who may still need to apply?**

Support and advice is available for those needing help with the online form or assistance with complex cases at the [Citizens Advice Bureau](#). Citizens Advice Bureau Southampton has been funded by the Home Office to provide an EUSS support service to help vulnerable people in the region, and the Southampton Registration Service is offering an [ID scanning service](#). Guidance about how to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme is set out on the [Government's webpage](#) and is [available online](#) in 26 European languages.

### Additional info:

Latest figures show that 41,810 applications have been made from people living in Hampshire, which is nearly 100% of the estimated total number of EU citizens living in the county (based on ONS figures from 2019).

The EU Settlement Scheme is designed to protect the rights of EU citizens living in the UK. It involves an online registration process, which has been designed

specifically to enable those EU citizens, already lawfully based in the UK, to remain living and working in the UK after 30 June 2021.
