## **Coronavirus (COVID-19) Updating the NHS Capacity Tracker**

Dear Provider

As the number of Covid-19 cases in care homes across Hampshire have thankfully dropped from where they were in April, May and June due to your positive and safe practice, we continue to monitor reported issues with workforce, PPE and the number of Covid-19 positive cases across care services in Hampshire. While we all take stock of all we've learned over the last few months, we must continue to monitor the impact of the virus, and watch for any signs of increased transmission.

Hampshire County Council continues to use the information you provide via the NHS National Capacity Tracker as a source of information about the position of the care home market and to respond where serious issues are reported. Therefore, we would like to ask for your support and to take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of continuing to update the NHS Capacity Tracker regularly and often, to allow not only ourselves, but NHS colleagues and people looking at the national picture to have the most accurate and most up-to-date picture as possible of the position in Hampshire.

We have seen completion rates drop recently and are keen to reverse this downward trend.
