At OpenSight, we understand that growing up with sight loss can bring unique challenges for both children and families. Our Children and Young People service aims to create opportunities where young people can build confidence, try new experiences, make friendships and feel supported within their community.

We offer a range of activities, events, support and signposting for children, young people and families across Hampshire. From early years groups, to fun days out and more, our aim is to help children, young people and their families access opportunities both within and beyond education.



What we offer

Activities and Events

Inclusive activities, workshops, and family events for children and young people living with sight loss.

Family Support

Advice, guidance and signposting for parents, carers and families.

Support for Professionals

Working alongside schools, organisations and professionals to help improve understanding of sight loss and inclusive practice.

Early Years Groups

Our groups are held regularly at a number of community venues across the region, offering opportunities for families with young children to play, learn and connect.

Groups are currently hosted in Eastleigh, Hilsea (Portsmouth) and Basingstoke on a monthly or bi-monthly basis; however, this may be subject to change.

Key Stage 1 Groups

As your child starts school it's easy to feel less connected. Our Key Stage 1 sessions aim to enable you to meet other families whilst the children take part in fun activities and even practice some early habilitation skills.
