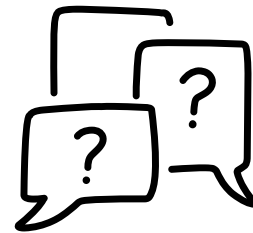


WHAT IS QUICK QUESTION CORNER?

What is the Local Area Partnership (LAP)?

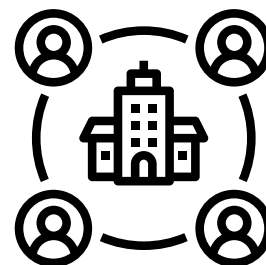


The Local Area Partnership is a group of people who work together to make life better for children and young people with SEND in Hampshire.



It includes:

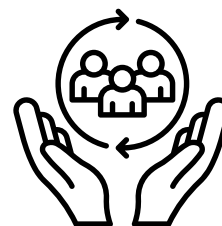
- Hampshire County Council

You are helping the Local Area Partnership make SEND services better for everyone.

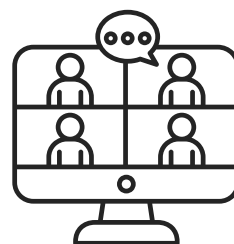


WHO ARE THE HAMPSHIRE SEND YOUTH FORUM?

The Hampshire SEND Youth Forum is all about giving young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) a real voice in shaping the services and support that matter most to them.

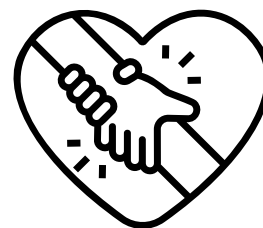


The forum meets regularly to discuss key issues affecting young people with SEND, from education to health and wellbeing.



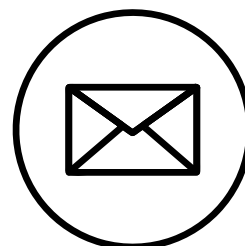
Are you interested in joining?

- Interested in working on projects that make a difference

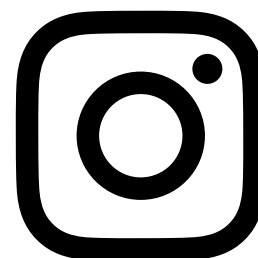

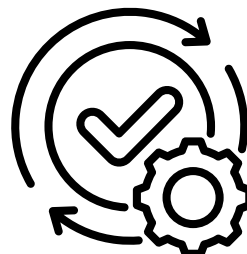

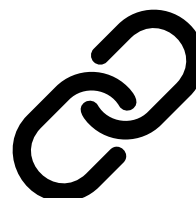
