

## Coronavirus (COVID-19) precautions



We wash our hands more frequently, for longer periods of time. We expect our visitors to do the same.



We follow the guidance of GOV.UK and Public Health England and amend our practice in line with current guidance.



We follow the guidance of the County Council, proactively check for updates to guidance, and have a rigorous system in place for risk assessment approval.



Neither staff nor visitors should be on site if they have had symptoms in for the 2 weeks prior to the visit. We follow the message of **catch it, bin it, kill it** and we display the posters on site.



We complete additional cleaning of toilets facilities, frequently used "touch points" indoors like doors and tables, but also of equipment.



We support our colleagues and visitors and help one another with concerns. We understand that this is a stressful time. Kindness and patience is important.



We operate a booking system for our site and are cooperating fully with the NHS Test and Trace Service. Staff and visitors are expected report and leave if symptoms develop while on site.



We prepare for the future including what will happen if we close. We do not charge schools for Covid-19 related cancellations.



Staff and visitors are expected to social distance and we ask that parents/carers help children do this. Unless exempt from wearing one, visitors should wear face coverings in line with current guidance.



We aim to work in ventilated areas and reduce direct contact.
