Jermyn's House

Jermyn's House is a large and elegant 18th century manor house that sits within 180 acres of beautifully curated gardens.

Originally the Hillier family home, it now contains the Garden Restaurant & Tea Rooms and serves as the administrative centre for the Gardens. The house also accommodates three meeting rooms, the Magnolia and Cedar Rooms on the first floor (accessible by stairs only), and the Roy Lancaster Room on the ground floor.

Jermyn's House is accessible via its own separate entrance and car park subject to prior arrangement.

Magnolia Room



The Magnolia Room is our largest space, located on the first floor of Jermyn's House (accessible by stairs only). It accommodates up to 40 people in theatre style, making it ideal for larger presentations. This bright, dual-aspect room overlooks Magnolia Avenue and the Jermyn's House lawn, formerly Sir Harold Hillier's private garden.

Roy Lancaster Room

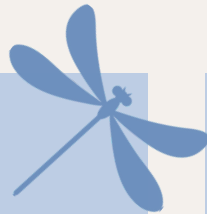

The Gardens lie between **Ampfield** and **Braishfield**, 3 miles from Romsey, and are signposted from the A3090, A3057, and Romsey town centre.

We're easily accessible by bus, train, bike, or car. Bus 66 connects Winchester and Romsey, with Romsey Station just 2 miles away. Free onsite parking is available, including accessible spaces, coach bays, bike racks and EV charging points.
