- B. £30,600 for families outside of London with two or more children
- C. £34,500 for families within London with one child
- D. £38,600 for families within London with two or more children

Please also provide a document to show **this for you and your partner** – this could be a bank statement, a pay slip or an employment contract **in your or your partner's name**.
