Supporting English as an Additional Language (SEAL)

EMTAS is pleased to offer this course for **Teaching Assistants** wishing to develop expertise in supporting pupils who are learning English as an Additional Language (EAL).

The course commences in the Autumn Term 2020. There will be six units available and these will be delivered one a term over a two year period. Each unit focuses on a different aspect of provision for pupils with EAL. The units cover:

- An introduction to Bilingualism
- The role of the Teaching Assistant in supporting EAL
- The importance of first language
- Effective strategies for supporting EAL learners
- The use of IT and other resources in supporting pupils
- Involving parents of pupils with EAL
- Strategies to support new arrivals and more advanced learners of EAL
- Assessment of EAL learners including SEN

Year 1

- 3 full days of input
- Tasks in school related to the input session
- Dates: 12th October 2020, 1st February 2021 and 17th May 2021
- Times: 9.30-3.30

Year 2

- 3 full days of input
- Tasks in school related to the input session
- Dates: 11th October 2021, 7th February 2022 and 16th May 2022
- Times: 9.30-3.30

Delegates who complete the course will receive a Certificate of Attendance from EMTAS.

All Key Stages will be catered for in the units.
