Supporting English as an Additional Language (SEAL)

EMTAS is pleased to offer this course for **Teachers** and **Teaching Assistants** wishing to develop expertise in supporting pupils who are learning English as an Additional Language (EAL).

The course commences in the **Autumn Term 2023**. There are six units which will be delivered one a term over a two-year period. Each unit focuses on a different aspect of provision for pupils with EAL. The units cover:

- An introduction to Bilingualism
- The role of the Teaching Assistant in supporting EAL
- The importance of first language
- Effective strategies for supporting learners of EAL
- The use of IT and other resources in supporting pupils
- Involving parents of pupils with EAL
- Strategies to support new arrivals and more advanced learners of EAL
- Assessment of EAL learners including SEN

Year 1
