Enhancing Skills and Techniques in the Primary Art Curriculum 2021



Great Artists, Craftsmakers and Designers




Participants will gain knowledge of how to meet the National Curriculum requirement that children at primary school learn about great artists, architects, craft makers and designers.

Using Sketchbooks at Key Stages 1 and 2

Exploring how the use of a sketchbook can be a very effective way of encouraging children to value their own thinking and learn from it.

During this two session course, delegates will:



- Develop a clear understanding of how to use the sketchbook to share a learning journey and for assessment.
- Gain an appreciation of how the sketch book can be used at KS1 in preparation for the statutory requirements in the next Key Stage.
- Be able to use a wider range of activities more effectively to record progression in learning and raise standards in sketchbook use at KS2.
