

This webinar aims to take you beyond the data to more detail of what it means to have a reading age of 6, or 9, or 17, and

how to adapt teaching to support readers at all levels. With the renewed emphasis on the effective teaching of reading across the school, understanding strengths and needs of readers at each level is relevant for teachers of all subjects and year groups. Included free as an accompaniment to this training, HIAS has developed a key new resource designed to help teachers of all subjects understand reading age data and adapt their teaching in manageable ways to support students to access the curriculum and make excellent progress in secondary school.
