Our Autumn term Primary and Secondary PDL offer

'Prevent' in the Context of Developing a Safeguarding Culture

This course provides an opportunity for teachers and leaders in schools to update their training on 'Prevent' and radicalisation. This replaces the previous 'WRAP' training.



During this two hour session, participants will:

- develop their understanding of extremism/ radicalisation
- examine expectations for schools
- identify whole school approaches for staff/ pupils/ parents
- investigate safe and effective teaching approaches
- learn about managing disclosures and responding to concerns
- look at how to plan lessons which make pupils less susceptible to extremist narratives.
