

Consultation on the future education offer in Whiteley and Fareham

Introduction

This consultation is open from Thursday 28 March until 11:59pm on Friday 31 May 2024.

Hampshire County Council will be building a new 900 place secondary school to serve the new housing development at North Whiteley. The new secondary school, known here as 'North Whiteley secondary' school, is planned to open in September 2027 for school years 7-11 and will admit up to 180 students per year group. The purpose of this consultation is to seek the views of stakeholders in the community on the proposed options to meet the future need for secondary school provision in Whiteley and surrounding areas. It is important to the County Council that the views of stakeholders in the community, such as schools, parents, carers, children and young people together with local residents who may be affected, are heard and carefully considered.

The responses provided will be used to support decision making on the proposed changes to education provision in the Whiteley and Fareham areas.

In order to do this Hampshire County Council will ask that you complete this form in which you will need to provide your personal data such as your name, the area in which you reside, your gender, age range, household income, whether you have any children, information about the capacity in which you are responding to the consultation, your views on the provision and information on how you became aware of the consultation. The form will also collect special category data in the form of ethnicity, sexual orientation and health information.

We collect and use the information ensuring that we comply with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UKGDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA2018) requirements for processing through Article 6(1)(e) of the UKGDPR where processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller. This public task is supported by Section 14 of the Education Act (1996). The processing of special category data is undertaken under Article 9(2)(g) of the UKGDPR where processing is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest which has a clear basis in law (Section 14 of the Education Act). The condition in UK law, set out in Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the DPA2018 is met through paragraph 6 where processing is necessary for statutory and government purposes.

All information collected from the forms will be held within the County Council's Document Management Systems (DMS) and will be kept in line with our retention schedule for two years and then securely deleted. No information leaves the UK as part of this processing activity.

Under data protection legislation, you have the right to:

- request access to your records;
- prevent processing for the purpose of direct marketing;
- object to decisions being taken by solely automated means;
- in certain circumstances, have inaccurate personal data rectified, blocked, erased or destroyed; and
