

Consultation on proposals to delivery budgetary savings for 2025

Introduction

This consultation is open from 08 January until 11:59pm on 31 March 2024.

Hampshire County Council delivers the majority of Hampshire's public services, to 1.4 million residents, and we are responsible for around 80% of all spending on council services in the county.

As our costs continue to rise, alongside growing demand for vital local services like social care for children and adults, our budgets remain under immense pressure. We need to identify savings of at least £132 million by April 2025 to help meet the expected budget shortfall.

The service change proposals outlined within this consultation would contribute around £17.5 million in total towards these savings, while ensuring that we continue to meet the statutory duties which we are required by law to carry out. You are invited to share your views on these proposals, to help us understand their potential impacts and any alternative approaches we could consider.

We are presenting these proposals as one consultation to help you understand the range of services affected and consider the combined potential effect on individuals, communities and organisations, but you can share your views on some or all of them, as you prefer.

Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs)

We are proposing to reduce the amount of money we spend on our Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC) network by a minimum of £1.2 million each year as we move towards a legal minimum service.

We are proposing a range of options that would allow us to operate within this reduced budget, whilst continuing to provide a sustainable, cost-effective and fit for purpose HWRC service for the residents of Hampshire in the context of ongoing budget pressures. These options are:

- Introducing charging for discretionary services
- Implementing alternative delivery models
- Changing the types of waste accepted at HWRCs
- Reducing the opening days and/or hours of HWRCs
- Reducing the number of existing sites

It is recognised that in isolation most of these options would not deliver £1.2 million in annual savings, so a combination of these would be needed to do so. As the largest savings can be made through closing HWRCs, this proposal is likely to feature in any recommendations. Feedback to this consultation will inform our view about what is the optimum operating model that would offer the best value for money as we move towards legal minimum level of service, while also becoming more financially sustainable.
