

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**Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981**  
**Schedule 14: Applications for certain orders under Part III**

*Form of applications*

1. An application shall be made in the prescribed form and shall be accompanied by:
  - (a) a map drawn to the prescribed scale and showing the way or ways to which the application relates; and
  - (b) copies of any documentary evidence (including statements of witnesses) which the applicant wishes to adduce in support of the application

*Notice of Applications*

2. (1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), the applicant shall serve a notice stating that the application has been made on every owner and occupier of any land to which the application relates.  
(2) If, after reasonable inquiry has been made, the authority is satisfied that it is not practicable to ascertain the name or address of an owner or occupier of any land to which the application relates, the authority may direct that the notice required to be served on him by sub-paragraph (1) may be served by addressing it to him by the description 'owner' or 'occupier' of the land (describing it) and by affixing it to some conspicuous object or objects on the land.  
(3) When the requirements of this paragraph have been complied with, the applicant shall certify that fact to the authority.  
(4) Every notice or certificate under this paragraph shall be in the prescribed form.
