1 The Application Route

1.1 Description

- a. Applicant Reference: Penton Grafton 501
- b. Classification of proposed route: Footpath
- c. Point A grid reference: SU 3295 5011 (application route junction with Nutbane Lane: 74U62 AK 05).
- d. Point B grid reference: SU 3304 4994 (application route junction with Penton Grafton 13 – footpath)
- e. Point C grid reference: SU 3315 4969 (application route junction with Penton Grafton 12 – bridleway)
- f. The application route length: 0.3 miles.
- g. Application Route Description: The application route passes from point A on Nutbane Lane at a point next to the perimeter of Woodview Farm. It then passes diagonally across a field to point B, which lies on the corner of Nutbane Copse. It then continues inside the perimeter of Nutbane Copse until it reaches a corner at which point it continues directly to point C. The aerial photograph with the superimposed OS 6 inch map clearly shows the route relative to the current topography.

1.2 Application Route utility (to assist Surveying Authority prioritisation)

- a. The application route provides a useful link between Tangley 4 (footpath) and Penton Grafton 12 (bridleway) and avoids road walking.
- b. When seen in the context of other applications in the area (DMMO 1225 and 1223) and Nutbane Lane that the application route adjoins at point A it can be seen that the route enhances the circular route possibilities in the area as shown on the map below.

- c. The route therefore significantly enhances the connectivity of these current rights of way in line with the policy described in the Hampshire County Access Plan 2015-2025.

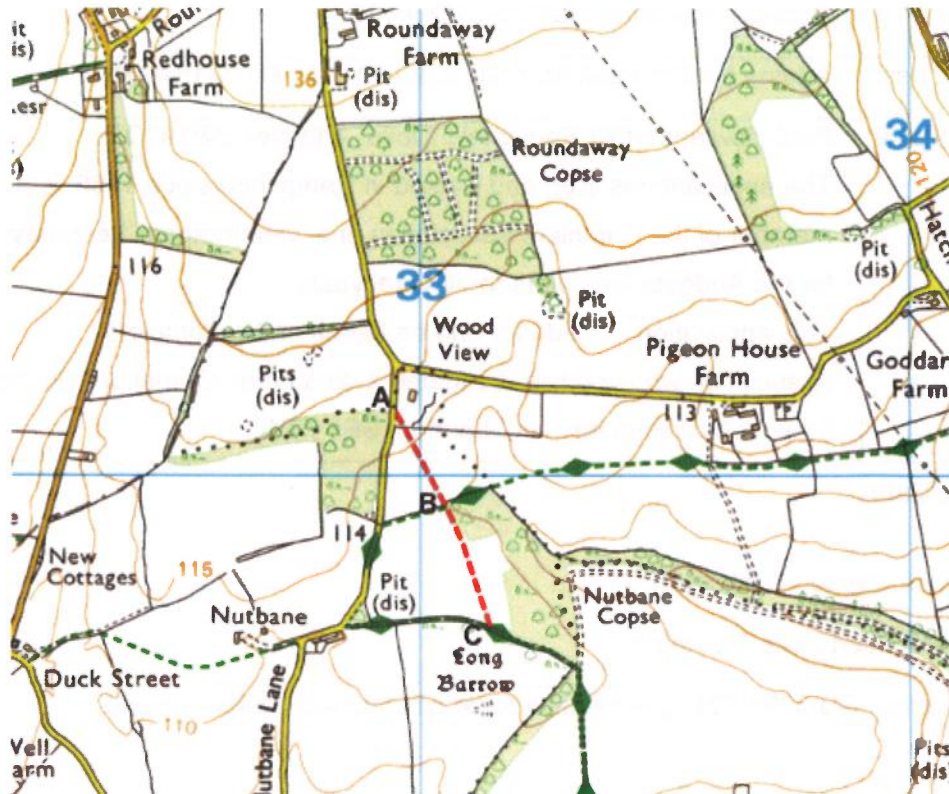


Figure 1. Extract Ordnance Survey Map at scale of 1:25000 showing the application route between A and C in red.

Schedule 14: Applications for certain orders under Part III

Form of applications

1. An application shall be made in the prescribed form and shall be accompanied by:
 - (a) a map drawn to the prescribed scale and showing the way or ways to which the application relates; and
 - (b) copies of any documentary evidence (including statements of witnesses) which the applicant wishes to adduce in support of the application

Notice of Applications

2. (1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), the applicant shall serve a notice stating that the application has been made on every owner and occupier of any land to which the application relates.
 - (2) If, after reasonable inquiry has been made, the authority is satisfied that it is not practicable to ascertain the name or address of an owner or occupier of any land to which the application relates, the authority may direct that the notice required to be served on him by sub-paragraph (1) may be served by addressing it to him by the description 'owner' or 'occupier' of the land (describing it) and by affixing it to some conspicuous object or objects on the land.
 - (3) When the requirements of this paragraph have been complied with, the applicant shall certify that fact to the authority.
 - (4) Every notice or certificate under this paragraph shall be in the prescribed form.
