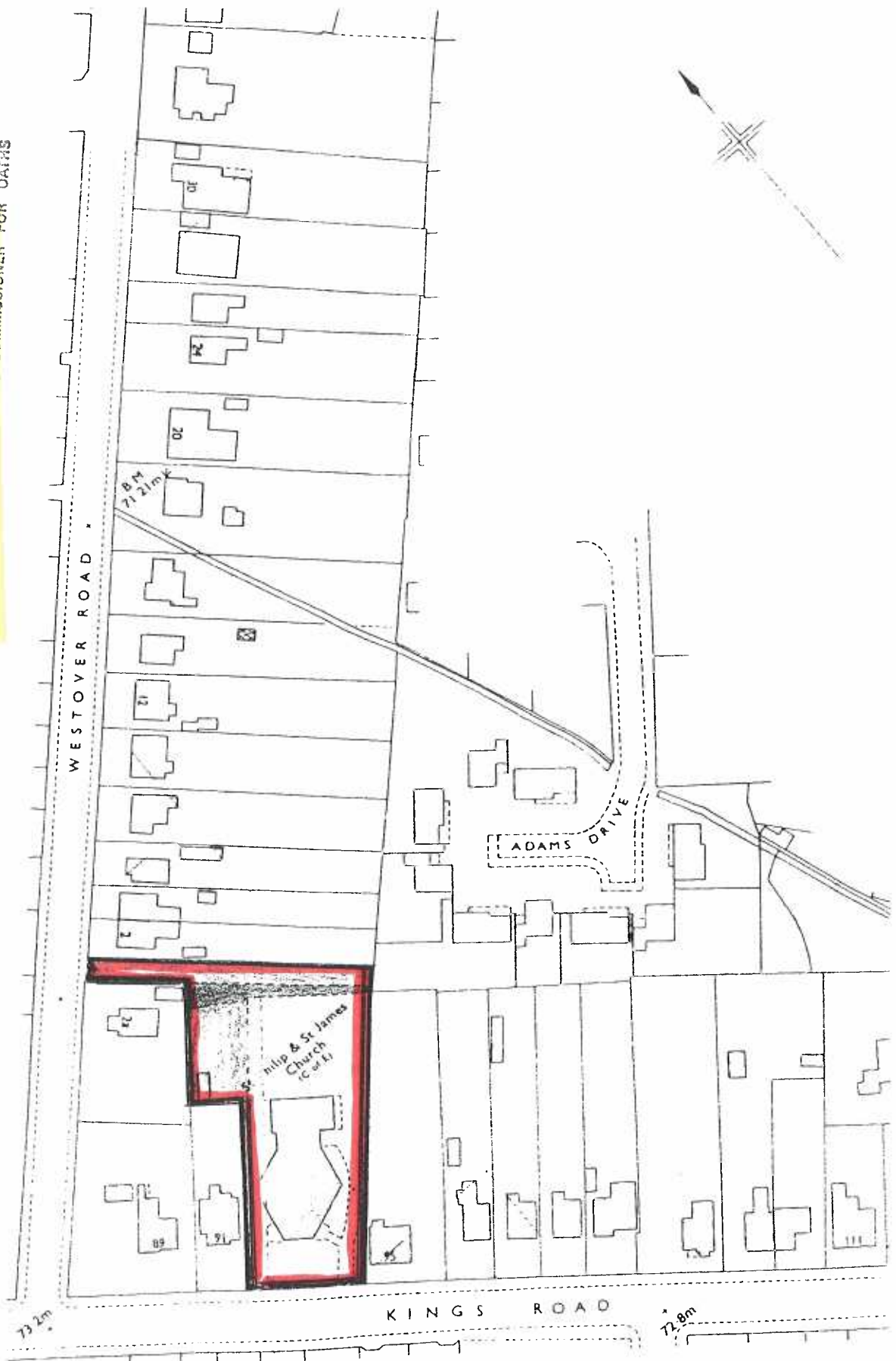

**Statutory Declaration
Section 31(6), Highways Act 1980**

I, DESMOND JOHN MICHELL WHITE, Professional Member of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors of Diocesan House, Quarry Street, Guildford, Surrey, GU1 3XG do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows:-

1. I am the Diocesan Surveyor and Property Manager to the Guildford Diocesan Board of Finance (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") whose registered office is situated at Diocesan House, Quarry Street, Guildford, Surrey.

The Board is and has been since the 27th day of April 1995 the owner of the land known as the Church of St Philip and St James, the adjoining hall, and car park lying to the north-east of Kings Road, Fleet and more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.

3. On the *fifth* day of *June* 2003 the Board deposited with Hampshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating the said land by red edging which stated that no ways had been dedicated as highways over the said land.
4. No ways have been dedicated over the said land which is edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement referred to in 2 above and at the present time the Board has no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over the said land.

And I make this solemn declaration on the *5th* day of *June* 2003, conscientiously believing it to be true by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
