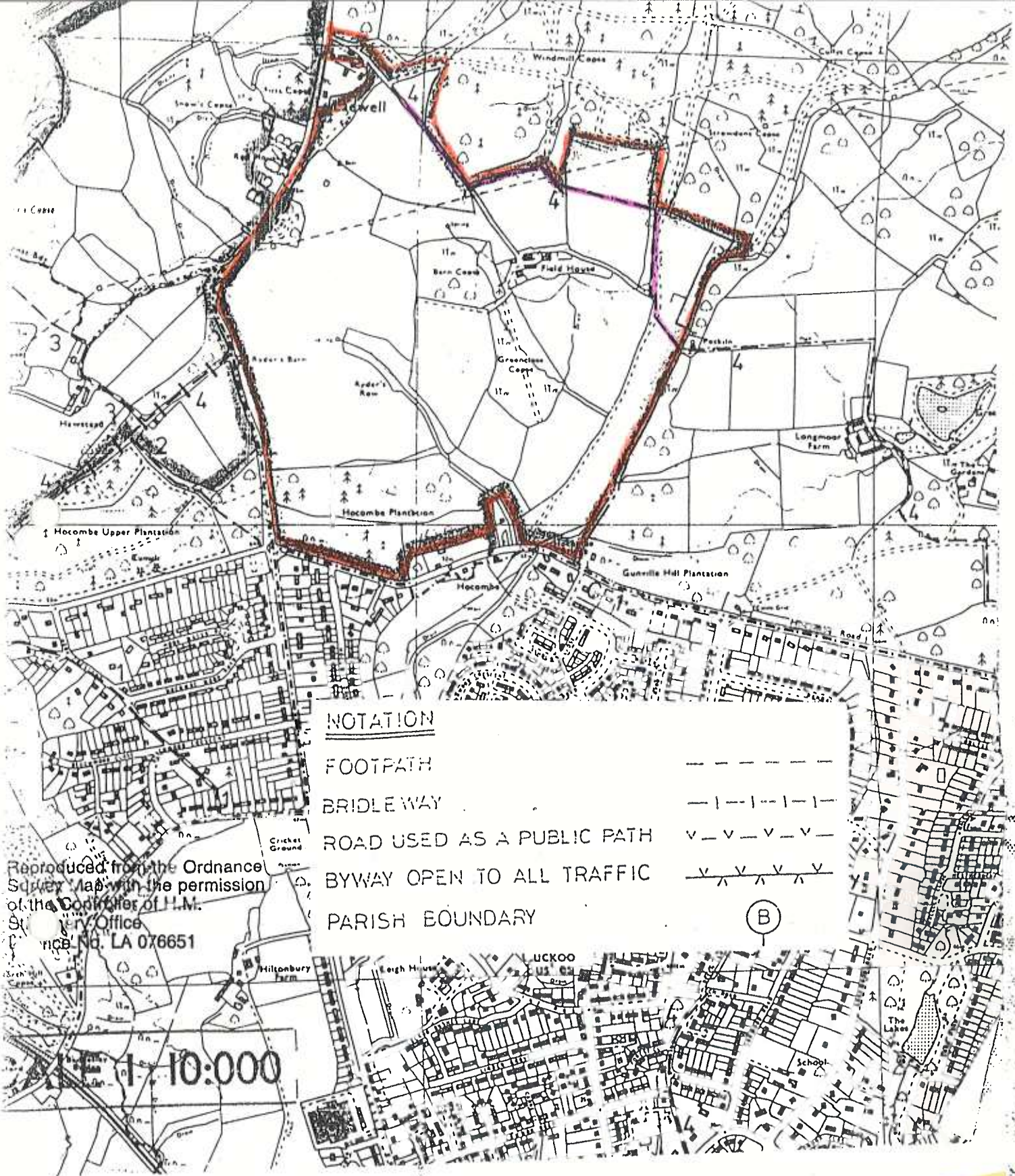

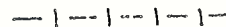

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I EDWARD JAMES WINGFIELD VISCOUNT LIFFORD DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. I am and have been since the sixteenth day of July 1987 the owner of the land known as Field House Farm, Hursley more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the fourteenth day of November 2002 I deposited with Hampshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths and no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated the fourteenth day of November 2002 referred to in 2 above and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 26 day of November 2002 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.


