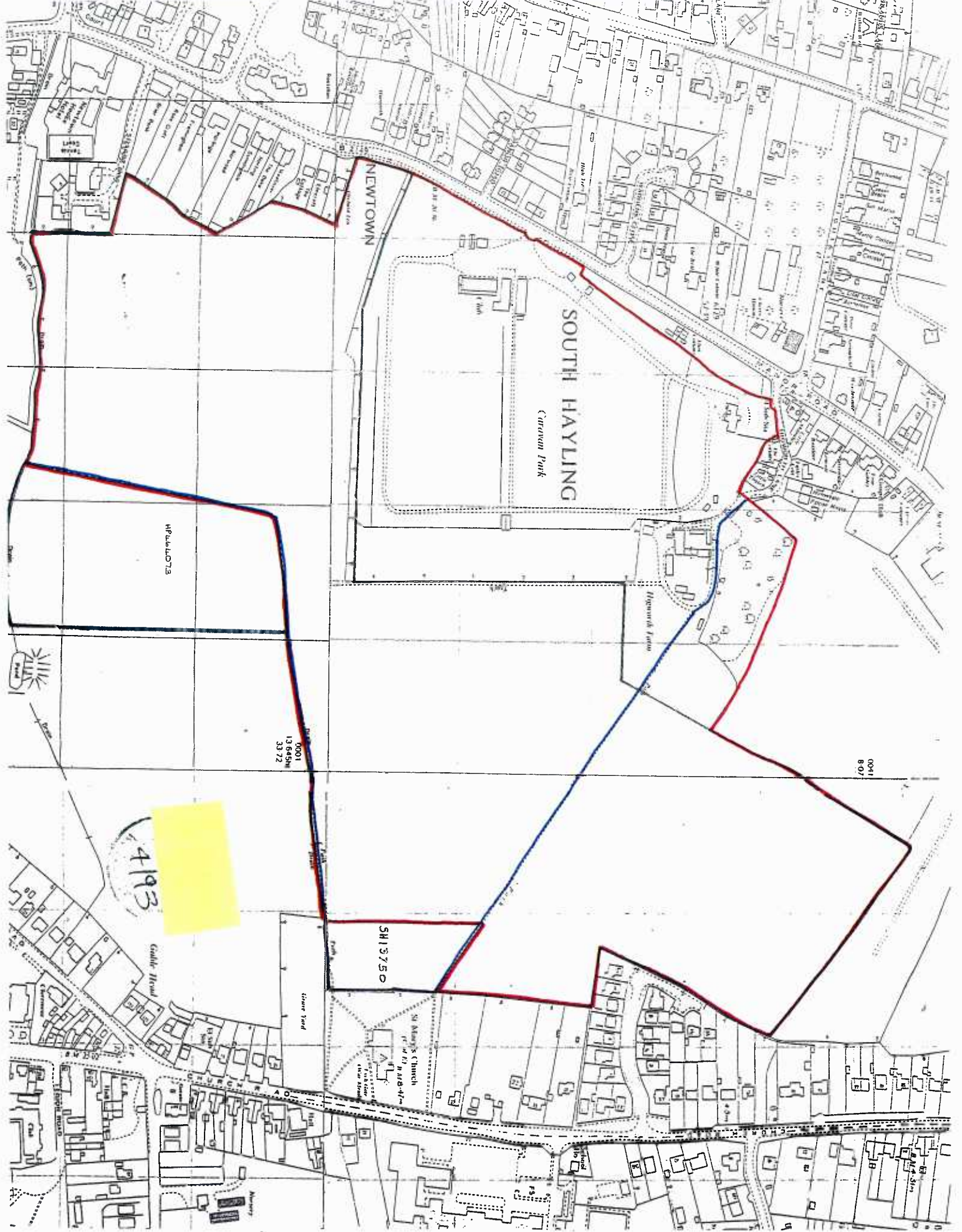

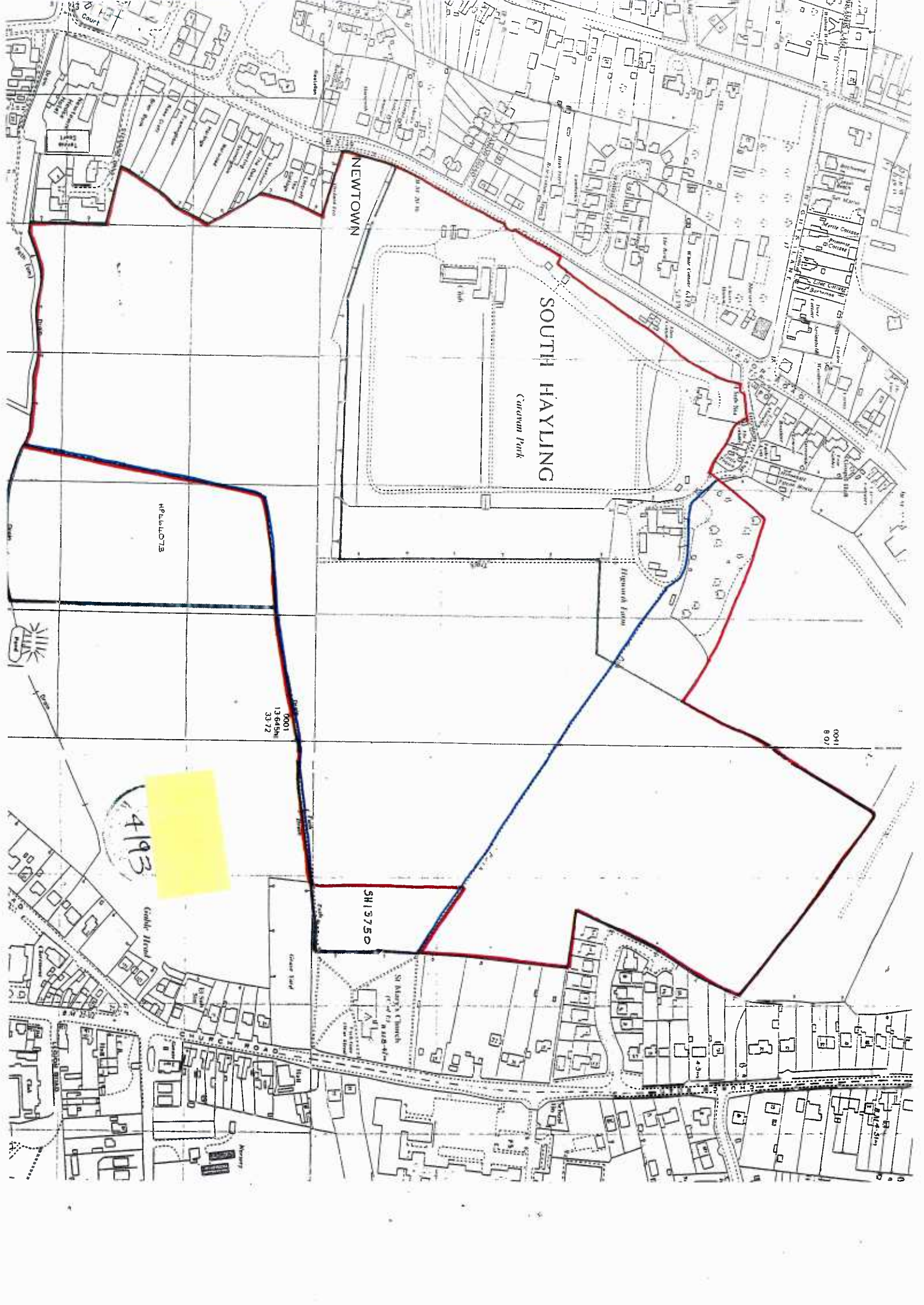
STATEMENT UNDER SECTION 31(6) HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
