


## Deposit of Statement and Plan

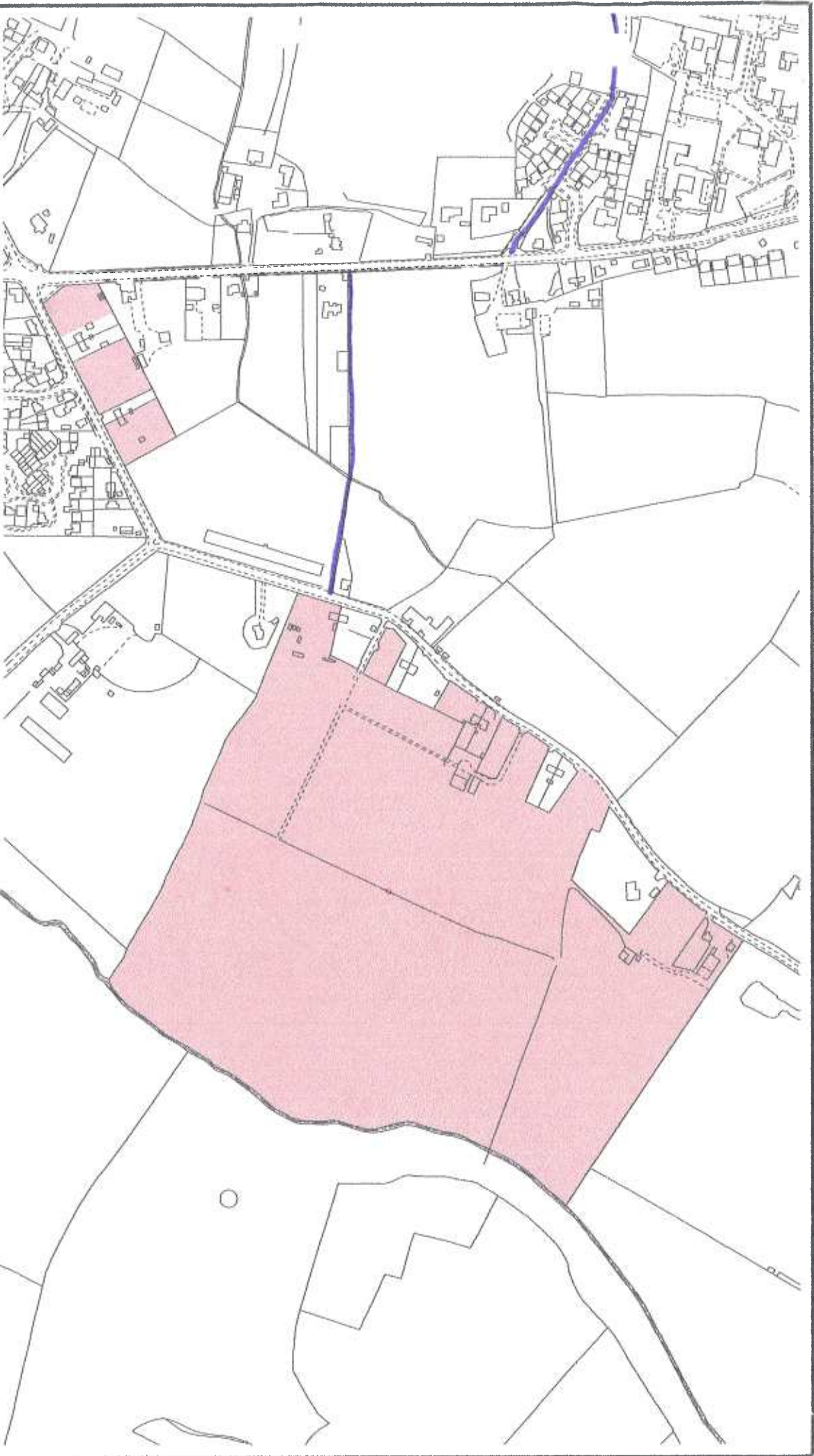
