Declaration made under Sect 31[6] of the Highways Act 1980**I, Bryan J.Raines make the following declaration.**

Passed to:

I am and have been since the 3rd October 1997, the owner of the land adjacent to Awbridge Village Hall and Sports Field. This land is a wildlife conservation area known as Aethelred's Park. It is situated at Awbridge Hill, Romsey Rd, Awbridge, in the county of Hampshire, as delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged in red.

As part of an environmental project started since at mid winter on the 21st December 1999, I have provided the public with permissive access to a Millennium Woodland walk. Access was originally restricted to an area of approximately 1 acre of newly planted woodland as shaded in green, however, since mid winter 2000, permissive access was annually extended by an acre a year to include new tree planting and to provide a link up to footpath 714 for walkers from the village hall. Today access is permitted to an area of approximately nine acres

Access to the site is through gates. All visitors are reminded on site, that they are on private property, a nature conservation area and that they are required to abide by certain rules. Missing signs are replaced periodically to advise visitor that they are on private property; of abiding by rules such as dogs on leads and staying out of restricted areas. Visitors to the site are also monitored daily and quickly challenged when not complying with the rules that they are required to adhere to.

On Tuesday 7th December 2009 this statement was served to Hampshire County Council Rights of Way Department, accompanied by a plan that is delineating my property in red edging, in order to confirm that there is no current right of way across my property and that it is not my intention to create any new public right of way in future. This statement confirms a footpath no 714 marked in purple, runs along but outside the south western perimeter of my property, as marked on the definitive map.

This declaration is made directly by myself to the Rights of Way Officer, Hampshire County Council Countryside Services, to protect my property in the event of persons assuming rights of access, to the wildlife conservation area I have created, where there is no right of way and never has been any right of way.

1. I am and have been since the 3rd October 1997, the owner of the land adjacent to Awbridge Village Hall and Sports Field. This land is a wildlife conservation area known as Aethelred's Park. As part of an environmental project started since at the mid winter solstice of December 1999, I have provided the public with permissive access to a millennium woodland walks and wild flower meadows. Access was originally by stile, replaced eventually with gates, where forestry commission signs make it clear that visitors are welcome. All visitors are reminded on site, that they are in a nature conservation. Missing signs are replaced periodically to advise visitor that they are on private property, of abiding by rules such as dogs on leads and staying out of restricted areas.
3. On the 24th November 2009 I completed this statement for forwarding to Hampshire County Council Rights of Way Department, accompanied by a plan that is delineating my property in red edging, in order to confirm that there is no current right of way across my property and that it is not my intention to create any new public right of way in future. This statement confirms a footpath no 714 marked in purple, runs along but outside the south western perimeter of my property, as marked on the definitive map.
4. This declaration is made directly by myself to the Rights of Way Officer, Hampshire County Council Countryside Services, to protect my property and prevent entry of persons assuming automatic rights of access to the wildlife conservation area I have created.

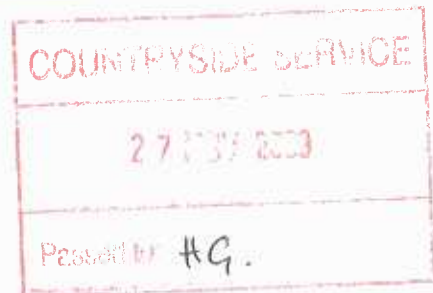
