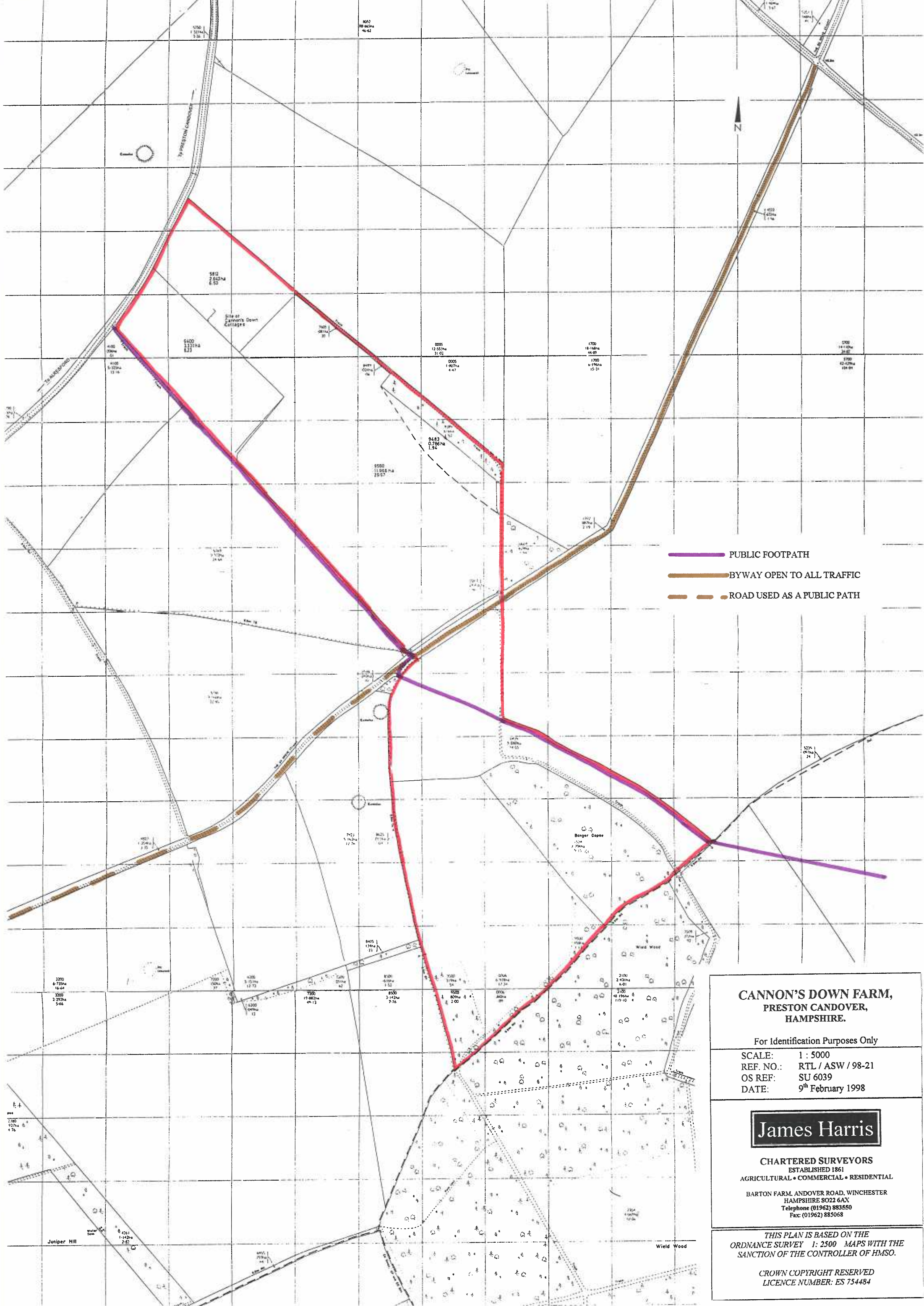

Statutory Declaration

Section 31(6), Highways Act 1980

I OLIVER GRANVILLE MILLS DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. I am and have been since 23rd July 1993 the owner of the land known as Cannon's Down Farm more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 13th February 1998 I have had deposited with Hampshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that: the ways coloured solid brown on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as Byways Open to All Traffic; the ways coloured broken brown on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as Roads Used as Public Paths; the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths; no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration in accordance with the statement of today's date referred to in 2. above, other than those Byways Open to All Traffic, Roads Used as Public Paths and footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration, and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.
