SECTION 31 - THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

- 1. I am directed to deposit with you, under the provisions of Sub-Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 the enclosed plans detailed in the attached Schedule of the Ministry of Defence Establishments within your area upon which have been marked all the ways which the Secretary of State for Defence admits have been dedicated. Will you please acknowledge safe receipt of the plans.
- 2. Your attention is particularly drawn to the legend on the plan, and I am to confirm that the extent of public rights recognised by the Secretary of State for Defence over each route shown on the plan is as follows:-
 - (a) Over each route shown by continuous purple line, the Secretary of State recognises a highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only.
 - (b) Over each route shown by a continous green line, the Secretary of State recognises that the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.
 - (c) Over each route shown by a broken green line, the Secretary of State recognises the way to be a highway other than a footpath or bridleway used by the public mainly for the purposes for which footpaths or bridleways are so used, or as a byway open to all traffic.
 - (d) Over each route shown by a continuous brown tint the Secretary of State recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.

Of the above highways, those described in sub-paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) are more particularly described in the definitive statement prepared by the County Council under the provision of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949, as amended by the Countryside Act 1968. The routes indicated by paragraph (d) are more particularly described in detail on the Plans attached.

- 3. In addition, in accordance with the above mentioned Act I am also directed to deposit with you the enclosed plans detailed in the attached Schedule of the Ministry of Defence Establishments within your area over which the Secretary of State for Defence states no ways have been dedicated as highways.
- 4. Statutory Declaration will be lodged with you from time to time as required.

STATUTORY DECLARATION FOR PRESERVING MOD RIGHTS IN PRIVATE ROADS AND FOOTPATHS USED BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC

I GERALD CHARLES BISSELL for and on behalf of THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENCE, and acting under the authority conferred upon me by the said Secretary of State DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-

- 1. The Secretary of State for Defence on the Twenty Fourth day of January 1991 the Thirteenth day of March and the Twenty Second day of November 1991 in accordance with Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 caused to be deposited with the Hampshire County Council and the appropriate District Councils the plans listed on the Schedule annexed hereto of certain Establishments vested in the said Secretary of State within the area administered by such Council together with a statement indicating what ways (if any) over that land the said Secretary of State admitted to have been dedicated as highways.
- 2. No additional way over the land delineated on a map so deposited with the Hampshire County Council has been dedicated as a highway since the date of the deposit.
