EASY-TO-MAKE...

EID MOON AND STARS

You will need:

- Paper plate
- Metallic paints
- Decorations such as gems, glitter and sequins
- 2 x lengths of gold yarn or ribbon

Other things you'll need:

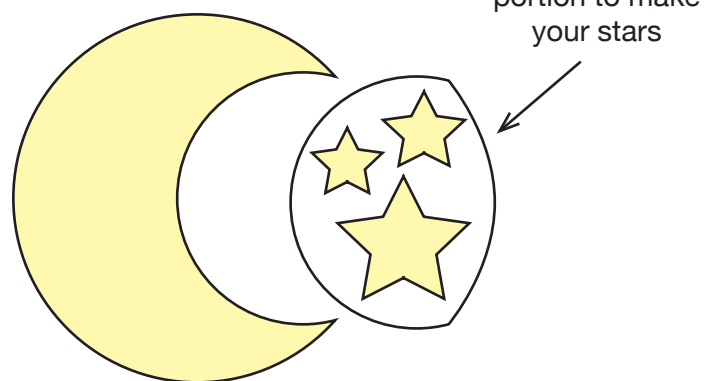
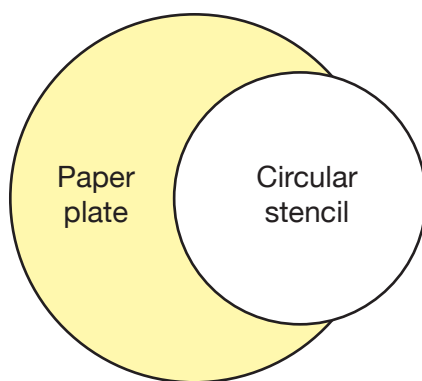
- Glue and scissors
- Hole punch
- Pencil
- Sticky tape
- Circular stencil (such as a small plate) to draw around



A pretty hanging decoration to make for Ramadan

How to make it:

- 1 Take the paper plate and place your circular stencil on top, just over the edge. Draw around the template to create a crescent shape in the paper plate. Cut along the line you have just drawn.



- 2 Draw stars onto the cut out portion of your paper plate. A template is given on page 2 of this instruction sheet. Cut out the stars.
- 3 Paint the stars and moon with metallic paints that will shine and catch the light. As this is a hanging decoration, it will look better if you paint both sides. Allow one side to dry before painting the other.

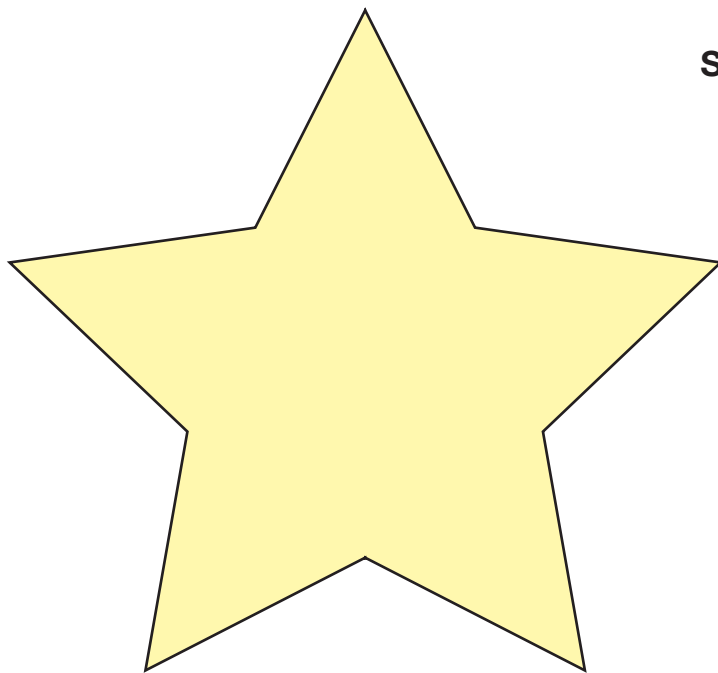

- 4 When the paint is dry decorate the moon with shiny gems, sequins and glitter. Glue your small stars to the plate.
- 5 Punch a hole in the top of the moon and tie on a length of gold yarn or ribbon. Hang up the moon to make the next step easier.
- 6 Punch a hole in the top of the largest star and tie on a length of gold yarn or ribbon. Attach the other end of the yarn or ribbon to the moon using sticky tape.

Tip: Use two paper plates to make this decoration and stick them together for added sturdiness.
