

# FESTIVE FAIRIES



Have fun  
scrunching  
tissue paper!

## You will need:

- Dolly peg
- Coloured tissue paper or pre-cut tissue paper circles
- Feathers
- Glitter (optional)
- Piece of wool or yarn (optional)
- Coloured paint

## Other things you'll need:

- Glue and scissors
- Felt-tip pens
- Stapler

## How to make it:

- 1 Begin by deciding whether to paint your dolly peg in a flesh tone or leave it unpainted. If you decide to paint it, do so now and leave to dry.
- 2 Add colourful paint to the middle section of the dolly peg, from where it splits to below the head, to make the fairy's bodice. Leave to dry.
- 3 To make the skirt, choose a selection of coloured tissue paper (or all one colour if you prefer). Cut out circles of tissue paper until you have approximately 10 tissue paper circles.
- 4 Arrange the circles in a stack and staple them together just off-centre as shown in the diagram.
- 5 Then fold the stack of tissue paper in half and in half again. Cut off about 5mm from the centre point so you have a hole in the middle when you open out the tissue paper.
- 6 Dress the dolly peg by pushing the tissue paper hole over the peg's head and down to the middle. Add some glue underneath to secure.
- 7 When the glue is dry, scrunch up the layers of tissue paper to create a ruffled 'tutu' effect.
- 8 Create hair either by gluing a piece of yarn to the doll's head or dipping it in glue and then glitter. You can also make shoes by dipping the feet of the dolly peg in glue and then glitter.
- 9 Use felt-tips to draw facial features.
- 10 Finish the fairy by gluing feathers to the back of the dolly peg to create wings.
