# RUDOLPH GIFT POUCH



#### You will need:

- Brown and white felt
- Red, black or brown pom-pom
- Small pom-poms or wiggle eyes
- Brown pipecleaner


#### Other things you'll need:

- Stapler
- Glue
- Scissors
- Black felt-tip (optional)

#### How to make it:


Start by cutting out your felt shapes. The main part of the gift pouch is made from brown felt. If you're using a piece that's A4 size, cut the piece in half lengthways. Then trim off about 4cm from the ends. This gives you two strips approximately 10.5 x 25.8cm (but it doesn't have to be that precise). Use the trimmed bits to cut out two brown leaf shapes for the ears. Then cut out smaller leaf shapes from white felt.

Trim off about 4cm from the ends. Use this to make the ears

- 2 Glue the white leaf shapes in place on the larger brown ones. Leave to dry.
- Then lay the strip of brown felt on the table in front of you. Position the ears as shown in the diagram, slightly overlapping the edge. Staple in place about 5mm from the edge.





Then fold the felt in half widthways, with the ears on the inside. Staple down each side, leaving the top open.



- Turn the pouch the right way out.
- Glue on a pom-pom nose and either pom-pom eyes or wiggle eyes (if you're using pom-poms to make the eyes, draw dots in the middle of each pom-pom with a black felt-tip). Allow the glue to dry before continuing.
- To finish, add sweets or a small festive gift. Secure the pouch closed by winding a pipecleaner around the open end. Arrange the ends of the pipecleaner to look like antlers as shown in the photo below.
