EASY-TO-MAKE...

POLAR BEAR CHRISTMAS CARDS

A cute way to use up leftover craft bits and off-cuts!



You will need:

- White A4 card sheet plus two small pieces of white card
- Green or red A5 paper or card
- Green or red extra fluffy (colossal) pipecleaner
- Wiggle eyes (optional)

Other things you'll need:

- Items to decorate the cards such as pipecleaners, glitter, metallic pens, sequins, stickers
- Glue and scissors
- Black pen or felt-tip

How to make it:

- 1 Start by folding the sheet of A4 card in half widthways.
- 2 Next, take the sheet of green or red paper or card and cut it approximately in half widthways. Glue the sheet to the front of the folded A4 card.
- 3 Then trace or draw around the shape below onto the two small pieces of white card. Cut these out and glue in place at the top of the card to make the polar bear's ears.
- 4 Cut a 15cm length of extra fluffy (colossal) pipecleaner and glue in place on the card to make the polar bear's jumper neckline (see photo).
- 5 Add decorative craft items such as stickers, pipecleaners and glitter to make the polar bear's Christmas jumper. When you're finished, set the card aside to allow the glue to dry.
- 6 Add the finishing touches to your card by drawing the polar bear's facial features. You can also glue on wiggle eyes for an animated effect.
