EASY-TO-MAKE...

WAGGY TAIL FATHER'S DAY CARD

A fun to make
Father's Day
card with added
'wagginess'



You will need:

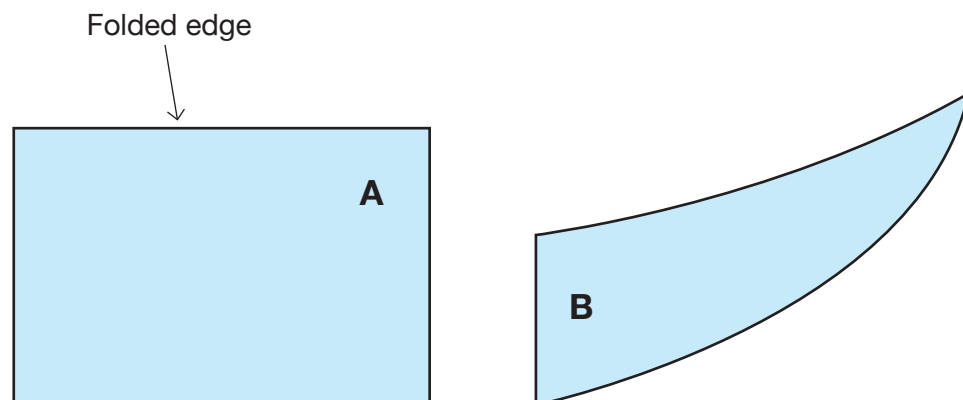
- Coloured card (A4 or A5) plus extra for decorating
- Craft foam shapes (optional)
- 2 x wiggle eyes
- 1 x small pom-pom
- 1 x paper fastener

Other things you'll need:

- Glue and scissors
- Pens and pencils
- Ruler
- A blob of Blu-Tack

How to make it:

- 1 Take a sheet of A4 coloured card and cut it in half to make two A5 sheets. Put one piece aside and fold the other in half widthways. **TIP:** Use a ruler to find the middle point and score along it with scissors. This will give you a nice clean fold.
- 2 Cut out all the shapes you need (templates are provided on page 2) from coloured card or craft foam, or use pre-cut craft foam shapes.
- 3 Place a blob of Blu-Tack on the desk to protect it. Carefully push through the front of the folded card at point **A** with the point of your scissors to make a hole (ask an adult to do this). Then make a hole in the tail piece at point **B**.

- 4 Attach the tail piece to the inside of the folded card using the paper fastener. Fold the arms of the paper fastener back to secure.
- 5 Glue the head piece in place on the top left of the folded card. Then glue on the ears and eyes and a pom-pom nose. Stick the spot pieces on the card, leaving space for your message. Glue one over the paper fastener to hide it.
- 6 Glue the feet to the card: stick one on each bottom corner of the front of the card and one on each bottom corner of the back of the card.
- 7 Lastly, write a message (such as 'I wuff you Dad!') on the front of the card. When you present the card, don't forget to tell Dad to make the tail wag up and down!
