

**FROXFIELD INFANT SCHOOL, FROXFIELD  
ALTERATION TO THE UPPER AGE LIMIT OF THE SCHOOL**

1. Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 19 (3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, that the Governing Body of Froxfield Church of England Infant School, High Cross, Froxfield, Petersfield, Hampshire GU32 1EG intends to make prescribed alterations to **Froxfield Infant School** by altering the upper age limit of the school to become a voluntary controlled primary school, to cater for 84 boys and girls, irrespective of ability, aged 4 – 11, with effect from 1 September 2013.
2. In order to achieve these intentions it is proposed that
  - (a) Pupils already in attendance at the school in September 2013 will be able to continue their education at the school until the age of 11, although parents will still have the option to apply for places at alternative schools.
  - (b) With effect from September 2013 the admission number for the school for pupils at age 4+ will remain at 15.
  - (c) With effect from the September 2014 and subsequent academic years the school will admit 12 pupils at the age of 4+.
