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1. The decision:

- a) That the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services approves the Children's Services Integrated grant applications of £5,000 and above for 2012/13, totalling £124,593 for organisations within Hampshire.
- b) That the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services approves the Youth Support Services (YSS) grant applications, totalling £15,906 for organisations within Hampshire.
- c) That the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services approves the Services for Young Children – New and Expanding Places and Sustainability Grant (SfYCNSG) awards of £5,000 and over for 2012/13 totalling £22,767 for early years and childcare organisations within Hampshire.

2. Reasons for the decision:

2.1. These decisions support the following Hampshire County Council priorities;

“Making Hampshire safer and secure for all” – by supporting organisations that provide positive activities for children and young people.

“Maximising well-being” – by supporting organisations that deliver services to children and young people, or aim to help vulnerable children and young people.

2.2. They also support the outcomes of the Hampshire Children and Young People Plan, the Local Children's Partnership priorities and all the five outcomes of Every Child Matters.

2.3. The YSS decisions will support the provision of local projects and services which have been steered by the Local Children's Partnerships in line with the government's commitment to the 'Big Society'. These services retain a focus

on young people who are the most vulnerable enabling them to access targeted services in their local area.

2.4. The SfYCNSG decisions helps the local authority to meet its statutory duty to ensure there is sufficient early years education places from within the private, voluntary and independent sector.
