1. Executive Summary

1.1. The purpose of this paper is to seek approval for funding of £10,000 to Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council for this year only, on behalf of the Local Strategic Partnership(LSP), to part fund a LSP Officer Post from the Basingstoke and Deane HAT Community Budget

2. Contextual information

2.1. Basingstoke and Deane LSP employs a LSP practitioner who is in post (and has been for a number of years). LSP partners have committed to jointly fund the post and this bid is requesting a contribution from Hampshire County Council towards this post for 2010/11 only.

2.2 The total funding allocation available to the Basingstoke and Deane HAT is £70,000

2.3 The amount of funding requested is £10,000 and the detail of the bid is set out in the application form accompanying this report (Appendix C).
