1. Executive Summary

1.1. The purpose of this paper is to seek approval for funding of £6,535 to Gosport Borough Council, on behalf of the Local Strategic Partnership (LSP) to part fund a LSP Office post from the Gosport HAT Community Budget

2. Contextual information

2.1. Gosport and Fareham LSPs employ a shared LSP practitioner who is in post (and has been for a number of years). LSP partners have committed to jointly fund the post and this bid is requesting a contribution from Hampshire County Council towards Gosport's element of the post for 2010/11.

2.2 The total funding allocation available to the Gosport HAT is £100,000

2.3 The amount of funding requested for this project is set out in the application form accompanying this report (Appendix C).
