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### **1. Executive Summary**

1.1. The purpose of this paper is to seek approval for funding of £10,000 to Fawley Parish Council from the New Forest HAT Community Budget.

### **2. Contextual information**

2.1 There are 27 Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) in Hampshire that rank within the bottom 20% most deprived in England, one of these is in the New Forest, in Holbury and North Blackfield, which is number 25 out of 27.

2.2 Relative to the New Forest, Calshot ranks as the 25th most deprived LSOA, which places it in the 40% most deprived in England. Calshot although not among the most deprived areas in the New Forest it does neighbour North Blackfield, the most deprived area in the New Forest.

2.2 The total funding allocation available to the New Forest HAT is £70,000

2.3 The amount of funding requested for this project is £10,000 to improve two play areas in the area, one of which is presently closed, which are much needed by the community. Full details of the bid is set out in the application form accompanying this report (Appendix C).
