Title of Bid/ Project	Tristan Close, Play Area Calshot, (£5,365) Queen Elizabeth II Recreation Ground Blackfield ((£4,435)
Summary of Bid/ Project	Tristan Close Play area is closed at present.. The funding will be spent on resurfacing a safety surface for play equipment. QEII safety surface is in disrepair and the funding will be used for resurfacing and the installation of a new slide . The total cost of repairing the QE11 play area will be £10,000, the remainder will be met by the Parish Council.

How does the Bid meet the HATs Term of Reference? 1) To tackle economic, social and health inequalities in the local area 2) To support the delivery of Hampshire's improvement priorities within the Hampshire Local Area Agreement* 3) To support local highways and transport priorities**	Calshot comes within the area of one the highest levels of deprivation in Hampshire. If the Tristan Close, Calshot play area is not in use the nearest play area is over 5 miles away and the bus service is very poor in this area.
Timescale (What is the anticipated period over which the money will be spent?)	Commencement Date: As soon as we receive the grant – say 1 June 2010. Completion Date: Work would take 2 days to complete.
Intended Outcomes (How will the success of the bid/project be measured?)	The Parish Council will be able to reopen the Calshot play area, which is currently closed. For the QE11 Recreation Ground the area will be safer and their will be better equipment The community will be able to make use of the play areas, which are much needed in these areas of relative deprivation.
Future Funding Arrangements (If the project is to last more than a year how will it be funded in subsequent years? How will any outcomes achieved by the project be sustained in the longer term? If it is a capital scheme how will the equipment be maintained?)	In future there will be an amount of £10,000 allocated in the maintenance budget at Fawley Parish Council annually so that a rolling programme of repairs can run. In future years maintenance of the Fawley Parish Council's play areas should be funded by Fawley Parish Council without outside grant aid.
