240. CHANGES IN RESPONSIBILITY FOR EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONS

1. Responsibility for Executive functions is set out at Part 2 Chapter 3 of the Constitution. Part 1 Chapter 9 paragraph 9.6.2 of the Constitution provides that responsibility for Executive Functions may be varied by the Leader at any time.

2. In consequence of the changes in the context of the services which are delivered by the County Council and the opportunities which exist to reshape the organisation, services, policy and partnership opportunities for the future, Councillor Stephen Reid was appointed to Cabinet as Executive Member for Strategic Development on 1 January 2012. The appointment of Councillor Reid as Executive Member for Strategic Development was reported to Cabinet on 23 January 2012.

241. CHANGES IN THE CONSTITUTION

1. In accordance with Part 1, Chapter 15, paragraph 15.3 of the Constitution, the Constitution is required to be amended to incorporate the changes referred to at paragraph 1 of this report. The consequential revision is set out within the Appendix attached to this Report.
