#### 1. Executive Summary

1.1. The purpose of this paper is to seek approval for funding of £10,000 to Fareham Borough Council from the Eastleigh & Fareham HAT Community Budget.

#### 2. Contextual information

2.1. Gosport and Fareham LSPs employ a shared LSP practitioner who is in post (and has been for a number of years). LSP partners have committed to jointly fund the post and this bid is requesting a contribution from Hampshire County Council towards Fareham's element of the post for 2010/11, together with funding towards a partnership project. The project has been commissioned by the LSP (Network Fareham) and is focused on tackling deprivation in Hill Park area. The levels of deprivation is well evidenced and detailed on the attached application form.

#### 3. Finance

3.1 The total funding allocation available to the Eastleigh & Fareham HAT is £110,000.

3.2 The amount of funding requested for this project is £10,000 and the details are set out in the application form accompanying this report. £6,535 is towards a shared LSP practitioner and £3,465 towards Fareham Park Project.

#### 4. Legal Implications

4.1. The County Council has the power under Section 56 of the Local Government Act 1958 to make contributions to the expenditure of a District or Borough Council in Hampshire.
