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#### 1. Executive Summary

1.1. The purpose of this paper is to seek approval for funding of £4,000 to Gosport Borough Council to deliver a Quit4life initiative in partnership with NHS Hampshire Community Health Care, from the Gosport HAT Community Budget.

#### 2. Contextual information

2.1. This application is for a bespoke smoking cessation project targeting smokers in Town Ward. Evidence shows that Town Ward has a high level of deprivation and smoking prevalence in Gosport is the highest in Hampshire at 27.4%.

#### 3. Finance

- 3.1 The total funding allocation available to the Gosport HAT is £100,000.
- 3.2 The amount remaining following previous successful applications is £80,965.
- 3.3 The amount of funding requested for this project is set out in the application form accompanying this report.

#### 4. Legal Implications

4.1. The County Council has the power under Section 56 of the Local Government Act 1958 to make contributions to the expenditure of a District or Borough Council in Hampshire.
