1. The decision: **(PROPOSED)**

- a) That the award of county-wide framework contracts, on the basis set out in the report, to ensure the continued efficient and cost-effective deployment of Intelligent Transport Systems in Hampshire, be approved.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. The award and implementation of Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) Framework Agreement contracts supports the County Council's corporate priorities of maximising well being and enhancing our quality of place. ITS provision contributes to the Environment Department's Aims 1, 3, 4 and 5 with particular emphasis on managing and maintaining Hampshire roads, transport systems and assets and to support and develop safe and efficient public transport systems to expand access and widen travel choice.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. Consideration was given to extending the existing contracts where possible and using ad-hoc procurement processes. However in order to test the market and ensure value for money and technical quality, a competitive tendering process was considered to be the most effective way forward. New contracts offer an efficient framework for the cost-effective, coordinated and consistent deployment of ITS in conjunction with the flexibility to respond to changing demands and funding availability.
