#### 1. Executive Summary

1.1 Under the provisions of Section 249(1) of the Local Government Act 1972, the title of Honorary Alderman may be conferred on someone who has, "in the opinion of the council, rendered eminent service to the council as a past Member of that council." The title cannot be conferred on a serving Member.

1.2 At present the Council has 21 Honorary Alderman:

1.3 It is proposed to confer the title of Honorary Alderman on the former Member of the County Council, Mrs Susan Glasspool.

Susan Glasspool was elected County Councillor for the Itchen Valley division in 1996 and served the division until her retirement in 2005.

She was a member of Cabinet from 2001-2005, serving as Executive Member without Portfolio from 2001-2003, Executive Member for Personnel and Training from 2003-2005 plus Executive Member for Adult Services in 2005.

She was Vice Chairman of the Policy and Resources Personnel sub Committee from 1997-1999 and Chairman from 1999 -2001. She was then

Vice Chairman of the Employment in Hampshire County Council Committee from 2001-2005.

She was a member of the Pension Fund Panel from 2001-2005 and the Standards Committee from 2001-2003.

She served on the Education Committee from 1996-1997 and then the Social Services Committee from 1997-2001. She was Chairman of the Independent Sector sub Committee from 1997-2000 and Adult Services sub Committee from 2000-2001. She was appointed Older Person's Champion from 2001-2005.

She represented the Council on a number of external organisations including South East Employers, Age Concern Hampshire, Blake's Educational Charity and the Manydown Joint Management Committee.
