Title of Bid/ Project	Chestnut Avenue Cycleway
Summary of Bid/ Project	<p>To implement a missing link in the Eastleigh Borough strategic cycle route network. The proposed route will be an extension to the existing off road, shared use, cycle route which currently terminates just south of the junction with Nightingale Avenue. The cycle route will then link to the existing cycle route network at the junction with Stoneham Lane.</p> <p>The bid will provide top-up funding to deliver the scheme.</p>

Encouraging cycling by providing a missing link in the cycle route network will improve accessibility to the Chandler's Ford business area and the town centre.</p> <p>2) Provision of an improved cycle route contributes towards the LAA targets of Health and Wellbeing, Childhood Obesity, and Accessibility. Also towards Road Safety, Reducing congestion and Climate Change by encouraging and promoting cycling.</p> <p>3) Cycle facilities support the Transport priorities by helping to reduce congestion, and improve Road Safety, and Climate Change.</p>
