### Details of the Bid / Project

<b>Title of Bid/ Project</b>	Installation of 2 new Bus Shelters
<b>Summary of Bid/ Project</b>	<p>There is a requirement for 2 new bus shelters within Fareham.</p> <p>The first is a replacement bus shelter that has the capacity for seating at Blackbrook Road and would be consistent with the new bus shelter that has already been installed on the opposite side of Blackbrook Road. Local residents have been in discussions with the Local Councillor as the current shelter is in need of repair and does not have seating.</p> <p>The second is a completely new bus shelter at Hillson Drive which is located in the area covered by the Fareham Park (ex Hill Park) Project and this is the most deprived part of the Borough, there is greater bus usage as only 53% of households have access to a car. As there is currently no bus shelter in this location user of the bus service in this area have no where to shelter during inclement weather whilst waiting for a bus.</p>
