The HAT Members agreed to write a letter to Chris Wilson and Ruth Olczyk to thank them for their work in the area.

A reduction in senior management of 25% has been implemented as part of the measures aiming to meet the financial planning targets for the County Council, and plans to rationalise and consolidate offices, looking at co-location with Amey, are being developed. The area-based planned maintenance activity will be consolidated under one team to improve the efficiency and coordination of this work. The modelled costs savings developed through 2010 appear to be in line with grant reductions and will meet the requirements going forward into 2011/12 and 2012/13. The Winchester team will be based in Bishops Waltham by September, full team there by March 2012.

**ITEM 2. Action Notes from Highways HAT Meeting held on 7 October 2010**

Members agreed the notes as a true record.

**ITEM 3. Matters Arising from Highways HAT Meeting held on 7 October 2010**

Members noted the updates.

Grit bins will be labeled over the summer. The process of installing new grit bins is ongoing.

Drainage work in Bereweke Road will go from the hospital along the full length of the road.

Hensting Lane should commence in May 2011.

**Action 1:** Chris Lait will ensure up to date information is sent to Cllr Mason regarding Hensting Lane.

The use of the Parish car park will not solve the issue of parking in Bishops Sutton.

Teg Down Meads will have the poor section resurfaced in 2011/12 (Cllr Dickens)

Stockbridge Road mini roundabout at Cheriton is in poor condition.

**Action 2:** Peter Eade will send a copy of the gully cleaning plan to Members along with confirmation of the dot colour to be used in 2011/12.

Members will send the location of blocked gullies direct to Peter Eade along with details of any gullies that are significantly overgrown. Many gullies have been "lost" to overgrowth and verge incursion in previous years and these can only be cleared when their position is known.

Mike Pillans circulated an up to date grit bin list. Parish bins on the highway will be filled but bins on unadopted roads will not automatically be filled.

**Action 3:** Mike Pillans will send round a list of new grit bin locations.

Members of the public are not able to buy salt direct from depots, however, Members may email requests to Peter Eade.

**Action 4:** Chris Lait will see if smaller bag of salt can be delivered to residents in the historic quarter of Winchester.

The gullies near the pond on Stockbridge Road and Chilbolton Avenue are blocked

**Action 5:** Peter Eade will look into the blocked gullies on Stockbridge Road and Chilbolton Avenue.

**Action 6:** Peter Eade will look into resurfacing at Folly Field in Bishops Waltham.

**ITEM 4. Progress with 2010/11 Schemes Programme (paper attached)**

Table 1. Maintenance and Special Maintenance Schemes Update 2010/11

Chris Lait updated Members on the progress on the Maintenance Capital Programme for 2010/11 relating to resurfacing and special maintenance. Members requested that officers let them know if schemes are deferred.

**Action 11:** Dominic McGrath will set up a separate meeting on NCN23, to be held with Winchester City Council.

Stanmore Lane and St Cross Road have had kerb improvements to improve sight lines.

3b) Minor Works under £50,000

4a) Hampshire County Council Programme

Bighton and Grundleton width restrictions could be quick wins.

Intec and Holiday Inn are putting pressure on the roundabout.

B3404, concern at delays.

**Action 12:** Mandy Ware will look into reconsidering the speed limits by Intec.

The consultation on Chilbolton Avenue is about to go to Members and has already gone to Hampshire Police.

Action 10: Mandy Ware will see if footpath widening on Otterbourne Road can be included in the list of schemes.

4b) Winchester City Council Programme

The Droxford speed limit extension is on the list of potential schemes. Safety schemes are not shown on this list.

Corhampton A32 limited waiting is no longer required.

#### **ITEM 5. Proposed Capital Programme 2011/12 (paper attached)**

Table 5. Chris Lait detailed the Under £50,000 Minor Works Sub-programme 2011/12.

Members noted the schemes and priorities for 2011/12. Attwoods Drive is being funded by Winchester City Council so the 314,000 can be reallocated. Members can send additional schemes to peter Eade.

Wavell way – potholes

Garbutt Road - potholes

B3047 - sides crumbling

Nursery Road – holes

Bridge Road – underlying problems

Ranscote Farm Lane – serious carriageway issues

New Farm Road – 2 phases, officers need to be aware of adverse publicity if a two phased approach is taken.

Wonston Close – potholes

Wonston Village – pot holes

Gabbet Road – black coming off concrete

Allans Lane – resurfacing on the approach from Medstead.

**Action 15:** Chris Lait will send details of the extent of the resilience scheme on Compton Street to Cllr Bailey.

Additional sites can be sent to Peter Eade.

Members noted the schemes and sites included.

Table 7. Capital Programme and Study Programme for 2011/12

Dominic McGrath outlined this programme. Developer contributions are funding the new pedestrian refuge on Otterbourne Road. The refuge will also slow traffic. Arlesford crossing points are still an important local issue. These will be taken up by Mandy Ware. Cllr Porter will email details to Dominic McGrath.

8c) A and B road speed limit review update

Mandy Ware circulated a list of sites. Recommendations are being finalized and a report will be available to Members in May 2011. E45 Pitt should include Pitt villages.

8d) New Scheme assessment framework.

This is work in progress to improve the efficiency of dealing with requests. This will provide a comprehensive assessment framework.

#### **ITEM 6. Local and Strategic Issues (paper attached)**

Dominic McGrath provide a verbal update on the following:

- Winchester Town Access Plan. Adoption is anticipated in June 2011.

- Local Sustainable Transport Fund. Local Authorities can submit one bid only. The main bid is for the North hants Sustainable Travel Towns project. The results should be known in July 2011.
- National Cycle Network. The Eastern lane scheme is close to completion. The feasibility study prefers Doman Road and the viaduct as the spine of the route.
